Advanced fire-fighting

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

Seafarers designated to control fire-fighting operations shall have successfully completed advanced training in techniques for fighting fire, with particular emphasis on organization, tactics and command, in accordance with the provisions of section A-VI/3, paragraphs 1 to 4 of the STCW Code and shall meet the standard of competence specified therein.

The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Acquired competences:

- Control fire-fighting operations aboard ships
- Organize and train fire parties
- Inspect and service fire-detection and fire-extinguishing systems and equipment
- Investigate and compile reports on incidents involving fire



Note: Fire fighting exercises will be held at the Fire-fighting Polygon. The polygon is an area of 16 ha with associated facilities, garage, open space for fire-fighting exercises, all associated fire-fighting equipment and personal fire protection gear.
