Advanced medical care certificate

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

Seafarers designated to provide medical care on board ship shall meet the standard of competence in medical care specified in section A-VI/4 of the STCW Code; and shall:

- have completed approved education and training and meet the standard of competence
- hold a certificate in medical first aid section VI/4-1

Every candidate for certification under the provisions of regulation VI/4, paragraph 2 shall be required to provide evidence that the required standard of competence has been achieved in accordance with the methods for demonstrating competence and the criteria for evaluating competence tabulated in columns 3 and 4 of table A-VI/4-2.

The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Acquired competences:

- Provide medical care to the sick and injured while they remain on board
- Participate in coordinated schemes for medical assistance to ships

Course duration: 5 working days
