

Dangerous goods handling

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

- (1) Masters, officers and ratings responsible for cargo handling on ships carrying dangerous and hazardous substances, according to International regulations, standards, codes and recommendations on the carriage of dangerous cargoes, including the International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code and the International Maritime Solid Bulk Cargoes (IMSBC) Code, shall hold a certificate in dangerous goods handling (STCW B-V/b i STCW B-V/c).
- (2) The certificate of competency from Annex (1) of this article shall be issued to every seafarer who accomplishes proper training from Annex D27 and passes the exam under Annex C36 of this Convention
- (3) The requirements referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article regarding training shall not be fulfilled by persons who have mastered the program during high school education, which covers all the contents of the program referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article.
- Course has been designed to meet requirements of STCW section B-V/b and B-V/c based on IMDG code and IMO model course 1.10. Course is intended for all shipboard personnel responsible for cargo handling aboard ships.
