According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

Crew members responsible for safety and pollution prevention duties must complete special programme before the first signing on and pass the exam to obtain a Certificate of proficiency – Basic safety training.

Main 4 modules are:

- Personal survival techniques
- Elementary first aid
- Fire prevention and fire fighting
- Personal safety and social responsibilities

The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Course duration: 6 working days
