

Ship security officer

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):


Every candidate for a certificate of proficiency as ship security officer shall:

- have approved seagoing service of not less than 12 months or appropriate seagoing service and knowledge of ship operations; and
- meet the standard of competence for certification of proficiency as ship security officer, set out in section A-VI/5, paragraphs 1 to 4 of the STCW Code.

The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Acquired competencies:

- Maintain and supervise the implementation of a ship security plan
- Assess security risk, threat, and vulnerability
- Undertake regular inspections of the ship to ensure that appropriate security measures are implemented and maintained
- Ensure that security equipment and systems, if any, are properly operated, tested and calibrated
- o Encourage security awareness and Course detailor: 2 working days
