Company security officer

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

Every candidate for a certificate of proficiency as company security officer shall:

- Be not less than 18 years of age
- Meet the standard of competence for certification of proficiency as company security officer, set out in section A-VI/5 of the STCW Code.
- Have completed the exam under Annex C34 of the Convention

The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Acquired competencies:

- Maintain and supervise the implementation of a company security plan
- Assess security risk, threat, and vulnerability
- Undertake regular inspections to ensure that appropriate security measures are implemented and maintained
- Ensure that security equipment and systems, if any, are properly operated, tested and calibrated
- Encourage security awareness and vigilance
