



Marine environmental awareness

According to the Ordinance on Vocations and Certificates of Competencies for Seafarers (of the Republic of Croatia):

- (1) Documentary evidence is acquired by a seafarer who completes the prescribed training in accordance with the program of Annex D48.
- (2) The requirements referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article regarding training shall not be fulfilled by persons who have mastered the program during high school education, which covers all the contents of the program referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article.
- (3) The documentary evidence has validity without time limit.

Course duration: 1 working day

Payment:

- credit card or bank transfer
- an invoice issued to a company

Course content:

Prevention of pollution of the marine environment and anti-pollution procedures:

- Knowledge of the precautions to be taken to prevent pollution of the marine environment
- Anti-pollution procedures and all associated equipment
- Importance of proactive measures to protect the marine environment

Course certificate: A course certificate specifying the training details will be issued by the Faculty of Maritime Studies Rijeka to each participant upon successful completion of the course. The Certificate shall be valid without time limit.
