SUMMARY

The goal of the MIMOSA project is to improve multimodal sustainable transport solutions and services by promoting a new cross-border approach to passenger mobility in the programme area. The main approach of the project is the establishment of cross-border cooperation by bringing together relevant key operators and actors in political, legal and institutional frameworks, as well as national and regional policymakers to solve common problems of predominant road traffic and low level of connectivity between the two countries provided a wider range of sustainable mobility opportunities, based on shared knowledge of transport demand and passenger habits and needs, making the project original compared to previous initiatives.

The main activities of the project are:

- Improving multimodal sustainable passenger connections through the development of improved connectivity of all modes of passenger transport through an improved network and connectivity of different modes of transport especially during the tourist season
- Providing better services for passenger mobility through harmonization and standardization
 of different types of smart solutions and technologies through smart and digital solutions:
 smart cards, integrated electric mobility system through which it will be possible to buy
 transport tickets, car-sharing system, traffic monitoring, upgrading existing solutions,
 improving the availability of all mobility solutions and for travellers with special needs
- The actions taken will increase multimodality and reduce noise and negative impacts of CO₂ emissions and noise pollution created by traffic
