SUMMARY

The main objective of TCC-SCV is to find a solution to problem of professional qualifications of individual Member States within the SCV (Small Commercial Vessel) sector are not mutually accepted between Member States. Despite the existence of a single internal market and greatly simplified administrative procedures for EU citizens to live and study anywhere in Europe, certain professional qualifications are still not accepted by the various Member States. Whereas merchant seafarers enjoy worldwide mobility thanks to international standards laid down in the IMO Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping (STCW) Convention, there is no equivalent for skippers of vessels up to 24m in length. This project will analyse six professional SCV skipper qualifications from UK, France, Spain, Germany, Slovenia and Croatia by breaking them into their smallest parts called Fundamental Elements and thereby offering objective comparability.
